## Game Instructions:

1. 2 people play the game by picking a category of words.
2. The $1^{\text {st }}$ player begins by saying a word
3. The $2^{\text {nd }}$ player repeats the $1^{\text {st }}$ word, and then says a new word.
4. The $1^{\text {st }}$ player repeats the $1^{\text {st }}$ word, the $2^{\text {nd }}$ word, and then a new word. Players continue back and forth until a player forgets the list of words.
**** If you want to increase learning, allow players to make 2 mistakes or get 2 hints. If you want the make the game more difficult, pick more than one category of words to choose from.
